

WORDONWEB (WOW) PROGRAMME - LENT 2008

Each session starts at 8.00 pm

It is our belief that the sessions are best conducted in a group setting. If a group is interested the format is:

- a) the group listens to the presentation (30 mins)
- b) the group discusses the material (30 mins)
- c) the group joins in a Q&A session with the presenters via a telephone conference. (30 mins)

The technical requirements for taking part are

1. A computer with broadband access to download the podcast of the presentation which will be available a week in advance.
2. A room with computer, projector and screen to watch the presentation
3. A telephone with a speaker phone to take part in the Q&A session
